For all ranks

Yellow Belt

Orange Belt

All Yellow belt requirement + Tachi waza Ai hanmi katate dori ikkyo omote/ura Tachi waza Ai hanmi katate dori kote gaeshi Tach waza Ai hanmi katate dori juji nage omote/ura

Red Belt

All previous belt requirements + Tachi waza Gyaku hanmi katate dori ikkyo omote/ura Suwari waza shomen uchi ikkyo omote/ura

<u>Green Belt</u>

All previous belt requirements + Tachi waza gyaku hanmi katate dori shiho nage omote/ura Tachi waza gyaku hanmi katate dori kokyu nage omote/ura Tachi waza gyaku hanmi katate dori kote gaeshi

Ai hanmi – mirror stance Domo arigato gozaimashta - thank you very much Gyaku hanmi – opposite stance lkkyo – first technique Juji nage – crossed arm throw Katate dori – wrist grab Kokyu ho – breath throw Kote gaeshi – wrist turning Omote – moving in front of the partner Onegaeshimasu – please practice with me Ryote dori – two hand wrist grab Shiho nage - four direction throw Shikko – knee walking Shomen uchi – overhead strike Sumiotoshi – corner throw Suwari waza – kneeling techniques Tachi waza – standing techniques Ura – moving behind the partner
